- To promote pure and healthy amateur interscholastic basketball in the schools of Maine.
 - To promote a balanced relationship between principals and coaches in their respective schools concerning the administration of the game of basketball.
 - To help maintain the highest possible standards in interscholastic basketball and the basketball coaching profession and to work together for the improvement of conditions in Maine basketball.
 - To promote good fellowship and social contacts among coaches.
 - To honor and recognize players and coaches for their achievements and accomplishments in Maine high school basketball.
 - To honor and recognize other people outside the organization who promote and / or contribute to Maine basketball.
